ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

7.4 g/L GLYPHOSATE (present as isopropylamine salt) and 0.72 g/L TRICLOPYR (present as triethylamine salt) in the form of a ready to spray liquid.

PRECAUTIONS:

READ LABEL BEFORE USE. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. AVOID RELEASE TO THE ENVIRONMENT. Avoid contact with skin or eyes and inhalation of spray mist. DO NOT eat, drink or smoke during application. Wear protective clothing such as impervious gloves when spraying. Remove protective clothing and wash hands and face thoroughly before meals and after using the product. DO NOT allow pets and children to enter the treated area until the spray has dried. DO NOT allow spray to contact or drift onto plants (including turf grass) you do not want killed. If sprayed, cut off leaves or wash with water immediately to avoid injury. Harmful in the soil environment. DO NOT allow chemical containers or excess spray to get into drains, sewers, streams or ponds. DO NOT spray directly onto humans, pets, exposed food, food preparation areas or food utensils. Test on an inconspicuous spot before use. In case of staining, remove by washing and brushing. DO NOT apply into or onto water. **DO NOT apply on or around food or animal feed crops.**

FIRST AID:

FIRST AID: If poisoning occurs, contact NZ National Poisons Centre: 0800 764 766 or a doctor immediately. Get medical advice if you feel unwell. If product gets in eyes, wash it out immediately with water.

HOW TO USE:

DO NOT treat if rain is likely within 30 minutes. DO NOT disturb treated weeds for 7 days after treatment. DO NOT apply to frost damaged weeds or weeds covered with dust or silt.



- 1. CUT** - Cut the white ties to release the hose and wand.
- 2. CONNECT** - Connect the hose to the pack as shown. This is a quick couple system which is not reversible i.e. once in place cannot be removed without force.
- 3. PUMP** - Pump handle up to 20 times for 3 minutes of spray. After pumping, push handle down, turn clockwise to lock into carry position.

4. **EXTEND WAND** - Lift sprayer off bottle, push yellow button while pulling lance into spray position.
5. **SPRAY** - Adjust spray pattern by turning the nozzle. Aim 50 cm from target weed and press white trigger. Spray to lightly wet the leaves avoiding run-off.
6. **RETRACT WAND** - After use, push the yellow button and retract the wand to its original position before clipping it onto the side of the pack for storage. This will prevent the accidental release of spray solution when in the storage position.
7. **STORE** - Push pump handle down, turn pump handle and cap anti-clockwise to relieve pressure, then retighten before storage.
8. **REFILL** - to refill remove the pump mechanism by unscrewing in an anti clockwise direction.

WEEDS CONTROLLED	HOW TO APPLY
For the control of most weeds and grasses found on paths and drives e.g. dandelion, creeping oxalis, flatweed, poa annua and other grasses like couch, paspalum and summer grass.	Apply when weeds are actively growing. Spray to wet all leaves. Weeds may be removed 7 days after treatment. Perennial weeds may need a repeat treatment.

SPILLAGE:

Contain spill and absorb with soil, sand or clay. Recover into labelled container that can be sealed and dispose of to landfill.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL:

Store in the closed original container in a cool, dry place out of the reach of children. DO NOT store in direct sunlight. Dispose of empty container by wrapping in paper, placing in a plastic bag and putting in the garbage. DO NOT store at low temperatures. Avoid contamination of any water supply with the chemical or empty packaging. Dispose of any unused chemicals according to local regulations.
